AFTER SCHOOL FALL 2006 ENRICHMENT CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Arts & Crafts – Grades k – 5; 3:30 pm – 4:30 pm – Jessica Watt

Students will work with Jessica to draw, sculpt, paint, and create beautiful craft projects.

Students will work in a variety of media and learn new art techniques.

Wednesday afternoons for 8 weeks: 9/6; 9/13; 9/20; 9/27; 10/4; 10/11; 10/18; 10/25

Cost: \$45.00 including supply fee.

Pa-Kua – Grades k – 5, 3:30 – 4:30 – Master Eric Aaron Fromme

Mr. Fromme, a native Israeli, will teach the class in English with reinforcement of Hebrew vocabulary. The program includes: physical exercise and performance; structural discipline and listening skills; and self challenging and observation activities. This is a fun, safe activity which will motivate children to work out and have fun while doing so. They will learn basic stretching, simple kicks and punches, galls and self defense techniques. Positive reinforcement will be used throughout the program.

Cost: \$120

Chinese – Grades k – 5, 3:30 – 4:30 – Jie Wang

Ms. Wang has experience teaching young children through the “Chinese Camp” she offers during the summer and classes she teaches in Chinese language at other elementary schools. She will introduce students to Chinese language and Chinese culture. Students who have previously taken classes with Ms. Wang or have some Chinese language experience are welcome.

Cost: \$60.00, minimum of 4 students required.

Modern Dance – Grades k – 5; 3:30 – 4:30 – Keshet Dance Company

The Keshet Dance Company is a non-profit arts organization whose mission is “to inspire passion and open unlimited possibilities through the experience of dance by uniting professional dancers with the community.” Keshet mentors will teach basic dance vocabulary and warm-up, students will explore the creative and choreographic process – working with instructors to create an original dance worked that can be shared with the community.
